

What is the Summary Annual Report?

The Summary Annual report (SAR) is a summary of a retirement plan's financial information. The following report provides a financial snapshot for JACK BYRNE FORD EMPLOYEE SECURITY PLAN from January 01, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

Its purpose is to summarize information on the plan's annual report for current participants, former participants with an account balance and/or beneficiaries of a participant.

You are not required to take any action, but you can request a copy of the full annual report or any individual parts of the report at any time.

Summary Annual Report

This is a summary of the annual report for JACK BYRNE FORD EMPLOYEE SECURITY PLAN , EIN 14 1669001, for January 01, 2018 through December 31, 2018. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic financial statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by a combination of funding arrangements. Plan expenses were \$3,735. These expenses included \$3,446 in administrative expenses, \$289 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries and \$0 in other expenses. A total of 38 persons were participants in, or beneficiaries of, the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,356,271 as of December 31, 2018, compared to \$1,388,675 as of January 01, 2018. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its

net assets of (\$32,404). This decrease includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of the plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had a total income of (\$28,669), including employer contributions of \$0, employee contributions of \$60,227, and earnings from investments of (\$88,896).

The charge to cover copying costs will be \$1.00 for the full annual report or \$.10 per page for any part thereof. You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan:
